

Secretary's Report

Beginning in September 2025, Lincoln Film Society ran a 16-film programme, split into two, with the first part running until the end of the year and the second running from the start of 2026 up until the screening of *Nouvelle Vague*, where the AGM will be taking place.

The membership cost for the main 2025-26 season was £39. We decided not to offer 'half-seasons' this time around. 316 people signed up as members.

So, an average audience of 161 (*not including the two screenings where we didn't have the full figures*) and an average rating of 76%.

The society also ran a summer season of four classic thrillers between May and June 2025 at the Terry O'Toole Theatre. This was charged at £15 per person for the full season and attracted 87 members.

The society will be running another summer season in 2026, starting on May 22nd, with a French New Wave theme. This has been charged at £17.50 per person. The membership window is currently still open.
